ANNEX C TO MOUNT ISA RIFLE RANGE DATED OCT 09

CONDITIONS OF USE FOR MOUNT ISA RIFLE RANGE

- 1. It is the responsibility of the OIC Practice to ensure that the following conditions of use are strictly adhered to by all military members using the Mount Isa Rifle Range:
 - a. The cutting of trees or vegetation is forbidden.
 - b. The cutting of fences is forbidden.
 - c. The lighting of fires, except when approved cooking or heating appliances are in use is forbidden.
 - d. The interference with private or public property or facilities is forbidden.
 - e. Any damage by military personnel is repaired immediately. Damage to roadways and fences are classed as range damage. Any damage beyond the capabilities of the user unit is to be reported to Mount Stuart Range Control immediately (refer para 44).
 - f. Heavy vehicles are not to move off formed roads.
 - g. The speed limit for all military vehicles is not to exceed 15 km/h.
 - h. Engineer construction equipment and plant is only to be used on approved development tasks.
 - i. All rubbish is to be removed from the range.
 - j. Alcohol is not to be consumed by any military personnel whilst on the range.
 - All civilian personnel observing, visiting or using the Mount Isa Rifle range must comply with Range Standing Orders.
 - I. Prior to and at the completion of range practices, bullet scoops at the main strike areas are to be inspected and as required refilled from the stockpile of sand adjacent to the stop butts.
